

AutoCAD MEP - Project Managers

This course builds on the concepts taught in AutoCAD Essentials, focusing on topics for a Project Manager. Students will learn how to open a project, understand tool catalogs and styles, and export to different output formats. Students will also have an opportunity to practice different installation setups, understand styles, view section/elevation objects, use dimensions, display themes, and blocks.

Who should attend?

The target audience for this class includes the CAD managers, and Project Managers at MEP engineering firms.

Prerequisites

Before taking this course, students should have in-depth knowledge of AutoCAD features and functionality, and have experience with MEP engineering processes and terminology. Microdesk recommends completing AutoCAD Projects and Tools Essentials prior to taking this one. It's helpful if students also have a working knowledge of the Microsoft Windows environment.
