Using tools specifically built to support the collaboration of Building Information Management workflows with Autodesk® Revit® software, Collaboration for Revit with A360 Team helps you coordinate and communicate with all project members regardless of where they are located. This new service takes advantage of cloud services and web viewer technology to foster team communication. This course will review what is needed to setup, manage, work in, and collaborate using the service. The service itself has several levels of interaction, with some users being more of an IT or setup function, others focusing on the modeling and coordination usage, and still others needing to use it to communicate and review their features for everyone in the project workflow.
