What's New

- New release: **V1.5** of Microdesk **BIMrx**.

New Features

- **Support for Revit 2020**
- Cloud Model Support
- Append to existing selection
- Selective Parameter Export
- Type Parameter Export/Import
- Rooms/Spaces Export/Import
- Schedules Export/Import

Known Issues

- Revit elements that do not belong to a **Family with a Category** will **NOT** be exported (e.g. Building Elevations).
- **ElementId** fields exported as read only (e.g. Phases, Image).
- Elements without types are not being exported. E.g.: Views... and more
- Linked Models are not exported.
- Duplicate name parameters of the same type and category are not exported.
E.g. Exterior Curtain Walls have two parameters, both named "Angle". One grouped under "Vertical Grid" and the other one under "Horizontal Grid". This parameter will not be exported.
- The Revit model must be saved before a BIMRX export operation.
- Export attribute filter lost between Revit sessions
- Material Takeoff Schedules and Schedule Keys are not supported by the Schedule Export/Import
